The Glendale Fire Department is providing a Cadet Program that can give you some of the valuable training that will assist you in reaching your goal.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Age 19 or higher
- Completion of EMT-1 course within the first year of employment
- High School Graduation or GED
- Concurrent College attendance with a major in Fire Science or a related field.
- Valid "Class C" Driver's License

DESIRABLE TRAITS

- Ability to complete one 24-hour ride-along per month
- Ability to attend bi-monthly Fire Cadet meetings
- Bi-lingual skills highly desirable
- Commitment to seeking a Fire Service career
- Ties to Glendale Community
- Ability to commit to a minimum of 20 hours per month

SELECTION PROCESS

- Written test
- Polygraph test
- Physical/medical test
- Chief's oral interview
- Physical agility test
- Oral interview similar to that of a Fire Fighter
- Successful completion of background investigation
- Individual must be viable candidate for regular employment
